






Second Day of First Grade 8/27/09

7:45 - 8:30	Review the morning routine. (Take attendance, lunch count, pledge)
8:30 - 8:45 	Welcome students back and do the morning message. Have the students find capital and lowercase letters.
8:45 - 9:00	Read The Kissing Hand Poem. Find letters by giving the sound.
9:00 - 9:40 	Re-read the Kissing Hand. Have kids trace and cut out their own hand. Have precut hearts on 8 x 12 red paper available. On the heart, write the <u>child's name</u> kissing hand. Do not glue down the middle and ring finger--tuck them under so it's the sign for "I love you". Glue the hand onto the heart and fill in the child's name. Display on a bulletin board entitled "The Kissing Hand".
9:40 - 10:10	Do Reader's Workshop Plans
10:10-10:45 	Review rules and the star program and consequences. Talk about the 3 things we do to get quiet. What do we do when an adult enters the room? Practice. How do we treat each other? Read the class promise. Discuss and have student agree to the promise by signing their names on a star. Review lunch and playground rules and go to lunch.
10:45-11:25	Lunch
11:25-11:50 	Go to the bathroom, get drinks and Do Read Aloud
11:50-12:25	Special
12:25-1:10	Do Calendar and Math Lesson Investigation 1, Session 2 Do counting to 20 assessment sheet
1:10-1:45 	Review classroom routines, sharpening pencils, getting drinks, going to the bathroom, etc.
1:45-2:15	Give students some time to explore the room. Play computers, free time games.
2:15-2:30	Go through end of the day routine. Get things ready to go home.
2:20-2:30	Dismiss at 2:30
