




# Third Day of First Grade 8/27/10

7:45 - 8:30	Review the morning routine. (Take attendance, lunch count, pledge)
8:30 - 8:45	Welcome students back and do the morning message. Have students find sight words in the message.
8:45 - 9:00	Read The Kissing Hand Poem. Find sight words in the poem.
9:00 - 9:40 	Give students a copy of the poem, illustrate and put in the GO Book.  Reread the book.  Next do a graphing question in the pocket chart. The question we ask is, "Who is your favorite character in THE KISSING HAND?" Chester or Mom. Then discuss the results.
9:40 - 10:20 <i>Reading Time</i>	Do Reader's Workshop Plans
10:20-10:45 	Review rules and the star program and consequences. Talk about the 3 things we do to get quiet. Review lunch and playground rules and go to lunch.
10:45-11:25	Lunch
11:25-11:50	Go to the bathroom, drinks and then do a read aloud.
11:50-12:25	Special
12:25-1:00 	Next make kissing hand puzzles. Students can make raccoon puppets while we are doing these.
1:00-1:45	Do Calendar and Math Lesson Investigation 1, Session 3
1:45-2:15	Review places in the classroom and how we use them. When we have free-time, the library, computers, etc.
2:15-2:30	Go through end of the day routine. Get things ready to go home.
2:20-2:30	Dismiss at 2:30
